OVERVIEW

Glenville is a small school with average class sizes of 15, but has the opportunity and price of a large state school. Glenville State College is the best of both worlds. Over the last three years, GSC graduates have a 100% acceptance rate to Physical Therapy School, Medical School, and Pharmacy School. If you qualify for an \$8,000 scholarship, you can attend Glenville for less than \$18,000 per year. That is a great value!

INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL AID

The International Access Scholarship is an annual tuition assistance award of \$3000 available to eligible international students. International students must submit all application documents and have a TOEFL score of at least 550. Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 to continue to receive the Access Scholarship for a maximum of eight semesters.

The International Leadership Award is a \$1000 scholarship presented to highly involved international students maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and participate in campus activities and organizations. Selected campus work opportunities in the Office of Admissions or Office of Student Life may also satisfy this requirement. Two letters of recommendation must be submitted from faculty member(s), community leader(s), employer or other person(s) with knowledge of the students conduct and dedication to success. Students must submit a new Leadership Award application every year by March 1st.
