The main campus is located in downtown Huntington, West Virginia – a safe, small city of 50,000 people. Huntington is within 1-3 hours by car from Charleston (West Virginia), Columbus (Ohio), Lexington (Kentucky) and Cincinnati (Ohio). Undergraduate – secondary/high school diploma

2.5 GPA (on a US 4.0 scale)
TOEFL (IBT) 78 or IELTS 6.0 or *AE Level 6
ACT, SAT may be required
*no grades lower than C

Pathway

2.0 GPA (on a US 4.0 scale)
TOEFL (IBT) 60 or IELTS 5.5 or Password 6 or PTEA 44 or *AE Level 4
ACT, SAT not required for admission
*no grades lower than C

Graduate – US bachelor's degree or equivalent

Direct Entry

2.5 GPA (on a US 4.0 scale)
TOEFL (IBT) 80 or IELTS 6.5 or *AE Level 6
GRE, GMAT may be required
*no grades lower than B

Pathway

2.25-2.50 GPA (on a US 4.0 scale)
TOEFL (IBT) 70-79 or IELTS 6.0 or Password 7 or PTEA 48 or *AE Level 5
GRE, GMAT not required for admission
*no grades lower than C

English Language Programs

Marshall University offers academic Pathway and English language training programs through the INTO-Marshall University Center. Pathway programs combine intensive language study, academic skills development, and academic coursework. Academic English is an academically rigorous program providing international students with high-quality English as a Second Language (ESL) instruction and the academic skills to succeed at Marshall once their program is completed. The INTO-Marshall pathway programs are designed to move students successfully through the first year of a four-year undergraduate degree program or a two-year graduate degree program. Successful completion of the appropriate level of the INTO Marshall program fulfils the English proficiency requirement for direct admission to a degree program.
